	The school re-opened fully in September 21, with the end to bubbles and most COVID restrictions. Gaps in learning were assessed and any issues were identified on the class inclusion grids, and addressed through a range of whole class, group and individual intervention strategies. Support in this area was provided by additional LSA hours, and other initiatives funded by the Pupil premium, Catch-up and 1:1 tuition funding.
	Formal testing was reinstated in Summer 2022. The general picture across all year groups was that good progress had been made, and the children were now generally achieving the expected level in Reading & Maths (compared to pre-COVID levels). However, writing still lagged behind pre-COVID at the expected level, Above expected in writing was also a particular weakness.
	Phonics in Year 1 (78%) was above pre-COVID levels which indicated the success of the phonics intervention strategies and school development focus.
